Death Follows Paralytic Stroke

Mrs. Cora Robertson Expires Sunday Afternoon---Other Deaths Past Week.

Robertson—Mrs. Cora M. Robertson, age 68, died at her home in Brownstown Sunday afternoon at 2:15 e'clock. She suffered a stroke of paralysis several years ago from which she never fully recovered.

Funeral services were conducted at the residence Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. E. A. Dawson, pastor of the Methodist church, in oharge. Burial in Fairview cemetery. Mrs. Robertson was a native of Jackson county. She was born at Tampico November 12, 1868, the daughter of Hutchinson and Catherine Trueblood Sturgeon, both deceased.
