Heart Attack Fatal To Frank S. Robertson— Rites To Be Thursday

Frank S. Robertson, 82, former college professor, who had spent the greater part of his life in Brownstown, succumbed suddenly about 3:00 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at his home. Death is attributed to a heart attack.

A native of Lawrenceville, Illinois, Mr. Robertson was born on June 16, 1881, a son of the late Edmond S. and Mary S. Stanley Robertson.

He was graduated from Brownstown High School, held a B. S. degree from Franklin College and earned his Master's degree at Indiana University.

For several years he taught in high schools and later was a professor in the college at Danville.

He was a member of Brownstown Christian Church and wore a 50-year pin awarded him by Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, of Brownstown.

Mr. Robertson was never married.

Surviving are three brothers, Lynn Robertson, Brownstown R1, Dr. Ray E. Robertson, Indianapolis, and Wayne Robertson, Albuquerque, New Mexico, and two sisters, Mrs. Mary E. Cross and Miss Edna S. Robertson, treasurer of the Kieffer Paper Mills, Brownstown.

Two brothers and a sister are deceased.

Funeral rites have been set for 2:00 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home in charge of E. Lacy Satterfield, Christian pastor. Interment will be in Fairview Cemetery.
