Robertson—Leonidis Lafayette Robertson, whose critical illness was mentioned last week, passed away at the home of his son, Oscar Robertson, in Brownstown, Thursday morning at 7:15 o'clock, aged 80 years, 5 months and 9 days. He had been in poor health for the past two years.

Deceased was the son of Absalom and Adaline Sewell Robertson and was born in Jackson county August 7, 1849. He spent the greater part of his life in Jackson county. Fourteen years ago he moved to Parma, Idaho, where he resided until two years ago, when he came to make his home with his son, Oscar.

On March 18, 1875, he was married to Elvira Catherine Bultman. To this union were born six daughters and four sons. Surviving him are the following children: Mrs. Oma Meadows, Mrs. Erma Wade, Mrs. Mary Ross, Bert Robertson, Dale Robertson and Ralph Robertson, all of Parma, Idaho; Oscar Robertson of Brownstown. Also eight grandchildren, and two brothers, A. M. and Clarence Robertson, both of Moab, Utah. He was a member of the Methodist church at Pleasant Grove. His wife preceded him in death April 1, 1905.

Funeral services in charge of the Rev. L. S. Lovell, were held at the Methodist church Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
