## Ward Robertson Dies At Veterans' Hospital— Rites Held Sunday

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home in charge of Gene Dulin, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, for Ward Robertson, former Brownstown resident, who died Thanksgiving afternoon at the Veterans' Hospital, Indianapolis.

A victim of leukemia, Mr. Robertson had been a patient at the hospital since August 13.

Born in Brownstown on October 9, 1894, he was a son of the late R. L. and Kate Cash Robertson. He was educated in the Brownstown schools and served with the armed forces during World War I, receiving his discharge on May 17, 1919, from Camp Zachary Taylor.

A machinist by trade, he had been employed with the Naval Ordnance Plant in Indianapolis until failing health forced his resignation.

He was married to Miss Lillian Bryum, of North Vernon.

Surviving are two children, Harold B. Robertson, of Indianapolis, and Mrs. Thelma Jean Edmundson, of Jeffersonville; two brothers, Fred Robertson, of Seymour, and Harry Robertson, of Hollywood, California, and a step-mother, Mrs. Rose Robertson, of Tampico.

Interment was in Fairview Cemetery.
