Robert L. "Bob" Robison, 77, of Brownstown, Indiana died Friday, October 12, 2001 at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis, following a brief illness.

Mr. Robison was a veteran of World War II and served in the U.S. Army assigned to the Caribbean from 1943 to 1946 as a Technical Sergeant in Company "B", 1st Battalion, 150th Infantry, 38th Division, spending much of his military service guarding the Panama Canal.

He graduated from Brownstown High School in 1942 and attended the University of Nebraska as a freshman, participating in basketball and baseball. He graduated from Indiana Central College where he was a member of the basketball and baseball teams. He earned his Masters Degree at Indiana University. He retired as an educator, and served as a guidance counselor, basketball coach, principal, and social studies teacher at Tappanico, Modora, Clearspring, Oolitic, and Bedford North Lawrence Schools.

He also was a retired melon farmer and contractor and was active in the Old Time Basketball Tournament in Jackson County. He was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and American Legion Post 112, Brownstown, Indiana.

Born January 25, 1924, he was a son of George and Myrtle McKinney Robison. On March 6, 1953, he married Marjorie Stotz, who preceded in death on December 20, 1992.

Survivors include two sons, Steven K. Robison, of Seymour, and Jon C. Robison, of Brownstown; daughter-in-law Peggy Robison; four grandchildren, Jennifer, Mark, Lisa and Stuart Robison; two sisters, Mary V. Lubker, of Brownstown and Marcella Banister, Seymour; a brother, Dickie Joe Robison, of Brownstown, and nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Raymond "Friday" Robison and Clair "Poky" Robison.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Monday, October 15, 2001 from Spurgeon Funeral Home, Brownstown, with Pastor Michael Hogg officiating. Burial will take place at Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown, with full military honors by American Legion Post 89, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1923, Disabled American Veterans Post 47, and Vietnam Veterans Post 7, all of Seymour.
