Esther McNiece Rorig, 93, passed away Tuesday, September 3, 2013 at her home near Vallonia, Indiana after several months of illness.

Mrs. Rorig graduated from Brownstown High School in 1938 and became employed with the Jackson County Conservation office. Later, she was employed with the State of Indiana at Vallonia Nursery; and was later the matron at the Jackson County Jail. She also had worked as a secretary for Clarence Turmail Insurance. She was a former member of the Willing Workers Club of Pleasant Grove Methodist Church. Mrs. Rorig was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church near Vallonia and served as a member of the Sixty Plus Club of that church. She enjoyed playing piano for people and organizations – she was an accomplished pianist.

Born in Jackson County on September 13, 1919, she was the first daughter of Guy W. and Nellie White McNiece. On August 23, 1942, in Brownstown, IN, she married Edgar Rorig who preceded in death January 6, 1983.
