Charles A. Rose, Nephew Of Local Residents, Dies

Word has been received here by Mrs. Ora Davis and Mrs. Joe Kindred of the death of their nephew, Charles A. Rose, in Biloxi, Mississippi, on New Year's Day.

A disabled veteran of World War II, Mr. Rose, who had been suffering with a heart condition for several years, was found dead. He had previously been hospitalized in the Veterans' Hospital in Biloxi and also had been a patient for some time in the Veterans' Hospital, Dayton, Ohio.

Born on January 1, 1911, Mr. Rose was 46 years old the day of his death. He was a son of Mrs. Edna Bland Rose Boyd, of Columbus, and the late Asa E. Rose.

His mother and stepfather, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Boyd, of Columbus, two sisters, Mrs. Dewey Linder and Mrs. Prentice Coulter, also of Columbus, and a brother, Dick Rose, of Nashville, Tennessee, survive, in addition to the aunts in Brownstown.
