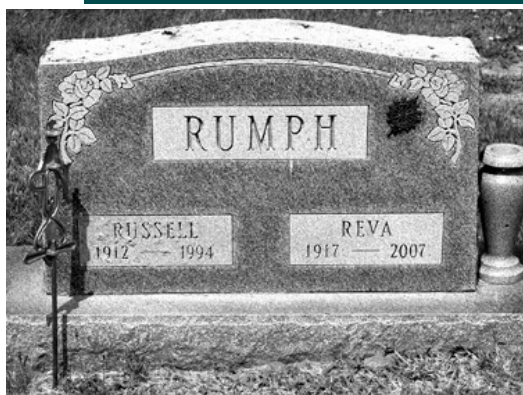

May 15, 1917 – July 30, 2007

Reva Irene Rumph, 90, Brownstown, died at 11:50 a.m. Monday, July 30, 2007, at Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown.

Mrs. Rumph was a member of Brownstown Christian Church. She retired after more than 40 years from the Jackson County Treasurer's office. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star 264 in Brownstown for 58 years and was a member of Daughters of the American Revolution, Fort Vallonia Chapter, of which she served as treasurer, regent and state credential chairman.

Born May 15, 1917, in Brownstown, she was a daughter of Dallas C. Spray Sr. and Zella Mae Cross, both of whom preceded her in death. On June 7, 1935, in Brownstown, she married Russell Rumph, who pre-

ceded her in death July 12, 1994.
