Charles F. Russell Expires in Brownstown

Charles F. Russell, 56, a veteran of World War I, died late Tuesday afternoon at the home in Brownstown, after an illness of nine weeks' duration. Mr. Russell had been in failing health for the past nine years.

Born in Hamilton township on April 7, 1893, the son of John W. Russell and the late Estella Robertson Russell, Mr. Russell had resided in various cities before moving to Brownstown five years ago to make his home with his father and sister, Miss Jeanette Russell. A salesman by occupation, he was employed in Indianapolis prior to moving to Brownstown.

Well known in Brownstown, Mr. Russell was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and of Washington Lodge No. 13, F. and A. M.

Survivors in addition to the father and sister include two brothers, J. Louis Russell, of Ewing, and John R. Russell, of Indianapolis.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, in Brownstown, with T. J. Due and the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.
