Leslie Ruel Russell, 75, of Tucson, Ariz., died at 12:20 p.m. Wednesday, April 28, in Tucson. He had been in failing health for two years.

Funeral will be at 1:30 p.m. Sunday, May 2, at the Voss Funeral Home in Seymour with the Rev. Wayne Yeater officiating. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.

Persons may call at the funeral home from 7 to 9 p.m. today, Saturday, May 1. A Masonic service is planned at 8 p.m. today.

Russell retired in 1968 from the Commonwealth Edison Company where he was a staff assistant to the vice president. He held various executive positions with the company.

A graduate of Seymour High School, Russell studied electrical engineering at Purdue University. He was a member of the Ottawa Street United Methodist Church in Tucson and of a Masonic lodge.

Born July 25, 1906, in Seymour, he was a son of the late George Edward and Ida Lucas Russell. He married the former Catherine James on Dec. 24, 1928, and she survives.
