Charles H. Rust, 78, Dies In Indianapolis

Charles H. Rust, 78, of 304 North Walcott street, Indianapolis, former Jackson County and Seymour resident, died at 9:30 p. m. Friday at the Barton House Nursing Home, Indianapolis. He had been ill for the past seven weeks.

Born in Jackson County Oct. 10, 1887, Mr. Rust was the son of the late Henry and Clara Robertson Rust. He farmed in Hamilton township for many years and following his retirement from farming, he lived in Seymour for several years.
