James W. Rust, Native Of Shieldstown, Buried In Fairview Cemetery

Burial rites were held Tuesday afternoon in Farview Cemetery here for James W. Rust, age 79, of Washington. Indiana, native of Shieldstown, who died at the family home in Washington last Saturday.
