### Mrs. Rust Expires— Rites Set Saturday

Mrs. Mildred L. Rust, 51, 201 East Seventh street, died at 3:15 p. m. Wednesday in Schneck Memorial Hospital after an illness of about three months. She had been hospitalized since Friday.
