Charles Victor Sage, 98, former Brownstown resident, died at 2 a.m. Tuesday, July 21, in Richmond where he had resided in the Friends Fellowship Community for four years.

Sage was a retired postal clerk for the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

He had served on the former Brownstown High School board of trustees and was a past master of the Washington Free-and-Accepted Masons' lodge at Brownstown.
