

## Russell Sage, Longtime B' town Resident, Dies

Russell Sage, 78, of Cincinnati, Ohio, a resident of the Brownstown area most of his life, died Wednesday in Jewish Hospital, Cincinnati, after an illness of about one month.

A 60-year member of the United Methodist Church at Brownstown, Mr. Sage was a mail carrier in Ewing for 16 years and had taught in a junior college and as a commercial studies teacher in a number of high schools. He had a bachelor of science and a master of science degree from Ball State College and was a veteran of World War I.

He was a member of Camp Jackson Post No. 112, American Legion, of Brownstown, of Washington Lodge No. 13, Free a n d Accepted Masons, o f Brownstown, and of the Sons of the American Revolution.

Born May 2, 1891, in Brownstown, he was the son of the late Walter and Katie Tapp Sage.

Surviving are one brother, Victor Sage, of Brownstown; one sister, Mrs. Ethel Prewitt, of the Methodist Home at Warren; one niece and three nephews.
