Mrs. Sanford Is Called By Death

Dies At Home of Daughter, Mrs. W. P. Stall. At Brownstown Early Today.

Mrs. Martha Jane Sanford, age seventy-four, mother of Mrs. Wilhs P. Stall, of Brownstown, died at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Stall at 7:45 o'clock this morning. She had been ill since 1924 with a complication of diseases.

Funeral sources will be conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Stall residence with the Rev. J. C. Reynolds, of Brownstown, in charge, Burial in Brownstown Cemetery.

Mrs. Sanford was born on April 1. 1862, near Ladoga, Ind., the youngest daughter of Zachariah and Catherine Mahorney. She was married on April 30, 1891 to W. J. Sanford, a teacher at New Ross, Ind.
