Schafferman - Miss Schafferman, aged 83 years, months and 10 days, passed away at her home in Brownstown Saturday afternoon, March 20, 1943, at 4:10 o'clock. Death was due to complications. She had been in ill health for several years. She was able to be up and about the house until she was taken suddenly worse on Monday after-

Funeral services were conducted at the home Monday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock in charge of the Rev. Walter M. Zeanah, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian church. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
Miss Schafferman was a native

of Jennings county and was born at Vernon September 10, 1859, the daughter of Peter and Louise Seidel Schafferman. Her father died in 1863. When a small child she and her sister Clara, with their mother moved to Seymour. Then they went to Columbus, Jonesville and later to Browns-town, where their mother was married to Conrad Brodhecker. For many years the mother and daughters were engaged in the millinery and drygoods business in Brownstown and were well known over the county. She and her half-sister, Miss Margaret B. Brodhecker continued to make their home together.

In early life she was sprinkled and after moving to Brownstown affiliated with the Presbyterian church where she took an active part in church activities as long as her health permitted. She was of a kind and obliging disposition and was known to many friends as "Aunt Vinnie."
