Wilma I. Scharbrough, 84, of Indianapolis, formerly of Brownstown and Medora, died Sunday, Feb. 27, after an extended illness.

She graduated from Medora High School in 1938 and attended Indiana Central College, now the University of Indianapolis, and graduated from Indiana University. She was a school teacher and taught in Carthage, Medora and Brownstown School Systems for several years, retiring in 1986. She was a member of Brownstown United Methodist Church, Center United Methodist Church in Indianapolis, Delta Kappa Gamma Sorority, and Psi Iota Xi Sorority.
