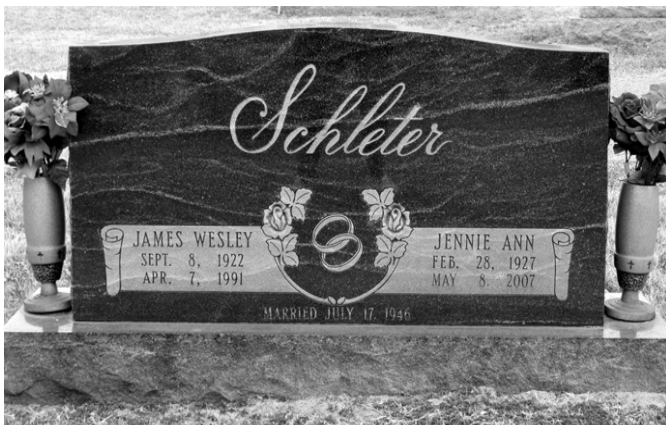

James Wesley Schleter, 68, of Brownstown R1 died unexpectedly at 4 a.m. Sunday at Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis.

A lifelong member of Brownstown United Methodist Church, he was a retired self-employed builder and carpenter. He was a World War II veteran of the 186th Black Hawk Infantry Division.

He had served on the church board of trustees for several years and was a past trustee of Brownstown Town Board. He was a member of Seymour Elks Lodge and had bowled with the Seymour bowling league for more than 40 years.

Born Sept. 8, 1922, in Brownstown, he was the son of William Henry and Mabel Hamilton Schleter. He married Jennie Ann Johnson on July 17, 1946, in

Brownstown. She survives.
