Frances A. Skinner Schulte, 90, of Franklin, formerly of Indianapolis and Terre Haute, died Monday, Oct. 1, at St. Francis Hospital and Health Centers.

She was employed for 25 years by Terre Haute First National Bank as a bookkeeper and deposit clerk, having retired in 1976. She was a member of Southport Christian Church and Brownstown Chapter 264 Order of Eastern Star since 1929.
