

## Edward R. Schwein Retired Saw Mill Owner, Succumbs

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon at the Johnnon Funeral Home, Vallonia, for Edward R. Schwein, well-known Vallonia resident, who for many years, prior to his retirement, owned and operated a saw mill and, in partnership with his brother, Frank Schwein, a threshing machine.
