WEEKLY DEATH RECORD
Schwein—G. Frank Schwein, age 48 years; passed away at the Methodist hospital at Indianapolis Saturday night at 7 o'clock. Death was due to Bantist disease.
Mr. Schwein was taken sick about two months ago. On February 2 he was taken to the Schneck Memorial hospital at Seymour where he remained until February 8, when he was removed to the Methodist hospital. The Wallace ambulance was called to Indianapolis and the body was brought to the family home, about a mile east of Brownstown, Sunday.
Funeral services in charge of the Rev. Roy Brumbaugh, pastor of the Presbyterian church, were held at the home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
Deceased was the son of George and Mary Fritz Schwein and was born in Brownstown township April 6, 1881. On June 29, 1907, he was married to Miss Myrtle Woodmansee of Brownstown and to their union were born two children of whom one daughter, Miss Frances, who with the widow, survive him. He also leaves his mother and the following brothers and sisters: Dewey, Ed and Everett Schwein; Mrs. Minnie Woodmansee, Mrs. Elmer Kennedy, all of Brownstown, and Mrs. Gladys Anthony, of Greenwood.
Mr. Schwein spent his entire life in Jackson county and for a number of years has been engaged in the saw mill and lumber business.
