Mrs. Myrtle W. Schwein Dies At Brownstown

Mrs. Myrtle W. Schwein, 77, a lifelong Brownstown resident and former school teacher there, died at her Brownstown residence about 7:15 o'clock this morning. She had been ill for several years with a heart condition.

Born March 4, 1878, at Brownstown, she was the daughter of the late Winfield L. and Eldora Wayman Woodmansee. She was reared in Brownstown and, on June 29, 1907, married G. Frank Schwein, now deceased.

Mrs. Schwein graduated from Brownstown High School in 1895 and attended State Teachers College at Terre Haute and the Indianapolis Conservatory of Music. She taught in Brownstown schools from 1900 to 1907.

She was an active member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church and taught Sunday School classes there for many years.

Survivors include one daughter, Miss Frances L. Schwein, at home, and a sister, Mrs. Bella Heller, now at the Roselawn Nursing Home, Seymour.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the residence in Brownstown with the Rev. Edsel Granger, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
