Clyde Self, 90, of Cortland died at 1:03 a.m. Monday, Oct. 5, 1998, at Lutheran Community Home, Seymour after several years in failing health.

He moved to Jackson County from Lawrenceville, Ill., in 1973.

He was a retired truck driver, and was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles and the Moose Lodge in Seymour.
