Keith N. Sewell, 71, Cortland R1, died at 1:35 p.m. Friday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital after having been ill for several years.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, a member of Brownstown Baptist Church and was retired from Arvin Industries and farming. He was a member of the Brownstown Masonic Lodge and Double Ten Euchre Club.

He was born May 16, 1913, in Honeytown to Mose and Theresa Edwards Sewell, both deceased.

He married Doris Smith on June 17, 1945. She died Dec. 30, 1974. He married Mary Thompson on Dec. 13, 1981, who survives.
