Leonidas L. Sewell Dies Early Today

Leonidas L. Sewell, age seventy-two, died early this morning at his home in Brownstown after a six-weeks' illness. A stroke was given as the cause of death.

Mr. Sewell was born August 4, 1873, in Brownstown township, the son of Elisha and Almira Bultman Sewell, who preceded him in death.

He was married October 20, 1900, in Seymour, to Miss Louella Klitch, who survives.

Other survivors include two children, Richard E. Sewell and Mrs. Lawrence C. McGil, Indianapolis, one brother, S. S. Sewell, of Chicago, and four sisters, Mrs. Walter F. Kaatmann, Crothersville; Mrs. Hollis Faultz, Olympia, Washington; Mrs. N. T. Moore, Atlanta, Georgia, and Mrs. Gladys Ross, Indianapolis.

Mr. Sewell was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, and had lived in Brownstown and vicinity all his life, except for a period of twenty years spent in Indianapolis.
