

Andrew Sharon Dies Today, Rites Saturday

Andrew "Shorty" P. Sharon, 95, 708 South Vine street, died at 7:10 a.m. today in his home after an illness of about three weeks.

He served with the Royal Canadian Army, was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Seymour, and had been employed as a machinist in Detroit, Mich.
