Mrs. Elizabeth Sharon Dies—Rites Wednesday

Mrs. Elizabeth A. Sharon, age sixty-seven, a life-long resident of Seymour, died at the home, 215½ South Chestnut street, early this morning. She had been ill for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Sharon was a native of Brownstown, where she was born on April 2, 1878, the daughter of Jefferson and Mary Corthum Weathers, both deceased. She was married on December 12, 1913, at Brownstown to Andrew P. Sharon, who survives. Her husband is a veteran of World War I, in which he served with the Canadian army.

Mrs. Sharon was a member of the Christian Church at Brownstown and made many friends throughout Seymour and the entire county who were shocked to learn of her passing.

Besides the husband, she is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Ethel Byers, and Mrs. Margaret Fields, both of Seymour, and two sisters, Mrs. E. C. Harmon, of Seymour and Mrs. Maggie Lebo, of Ft. Meade, Fla.

An infant daughter preceded her in death. She also is survived
