Mrs. Effie Shelton Dies Near Brownstown

Mrs. Effie Shelton, age seventy-two, died Sunday morning at her home two and one-half miles southwest of Brownstown. She had been ill for about a year, but had been critically ill for only a week before her death.

A life-long resident of Jackson county, Mrs. Shelton was born on October 24, 1871, in Brownstown township, the daughter of John and Mary Trowbridge Miller, both deceased. She was married on May 4, 1888, in Brownstown, to Edward Shelton, who preceded her in death several years ago.

A quiet, home-loving person, Mrs. Shelton had made a host of friends who join with relatives in mourning her death. She was a member of the Vallonia Christian Church, and leaves many friends among the members of the congregation there, also, who regret her passing.

Survivors include seven children, Forrest Shelton, Mead Shelton, Mrs. Bianche Boley and Mrs. Golda Banks, all of Brownstown; Price Shelton, of Louisville; Mrs. Edna Aufenberg, of Seymour; and Mrs. Bernice Reedy, of Brownstown.
