Heart Attack Fatal To George B. Shelton

Funeral rites were held Monday afternoon from the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home for George Bryan Shelton, of Brownstown, who suffered a fatal heart attack at his home, 108 Sycamore street, early Saturday morning.

The Rev. Staten E. Lightfoot, pastor of the Brownstown United Methodist Church, was in charge of the last rites and burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

A Brownstown native, Mr. Shelton was born June 11, 1897, a son of the late George and Emma Winkler Shelton. He was married, in Bedford, on March 2, 1935, to Kathleen Fleenor, who survives.

Also surviving are nine children and 12 grandchildren.
