John W. Shelton, 49, of 505 Sugar St., Brownstown, died at 6:15 p.m. Wednesday, March 7, at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Louisville. He had been in failing health for several years.

Mr. Shelton was retired from the armed forces, having served 23 years in the Army, including service in Korea and Vietnam. He was a member of Brownstown Christian Church.
