David Sherrill Killed In Construction Mishap

David Arthur Sherrill, 19, Medora, was killed Friday morning, June 14, in a construction accident at Mt. Washington, Ky.

The young man was employed for the summer by the Mitchell & Stark Construction Company. He was operating a backhoe, which came into contact with a power line, causing him to be electrocuted.

A 1972 graduate of Brownstown Central High School, Sherrill was a junior in the School of Pharmacy at Purdue University. He was a member of Mt. Zion United Methodist Church.

Born Aug. 15, 1954, in Jackson County, he was the son of Russell and Charlotte Lucas Sherrill, both of whom survive.

Other survivors are 3 sisters: Donna Kaye, who is studying at Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis, in the radiology department; Debra Ruth, at home; Diane Louise, at home; his paternal grandmother: Mrs. Ida Sherrill, Medora; and the maternal grandparents: Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Lucas Sr., Freetown Rt. 2.

Services were held Sunday, June 16, from the Spurgeon Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Arthur Fields, pastor of Mt. Zion United Methodist Church, and the Rev. Anand Swarup of Orleans officiating. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
