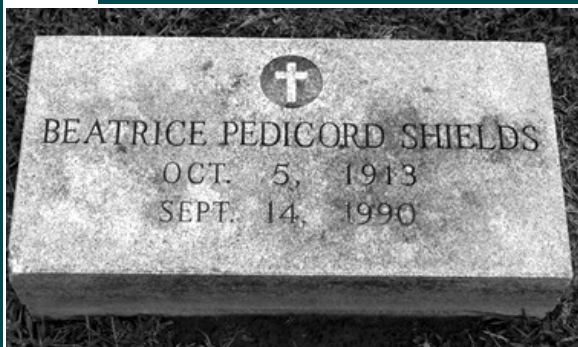

Beatrice Shields services Sunday; was active in medical auxiliaries

Beatrice Helen Pedicord Shields, 76, of Brownstown, died at 1:30 a.m. today at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital in Seymour. She had been ill for 15 hours.

She moved to Jackson County in 1928 and was a member of Brownstown Christian Church. She was the author of "Sharing Faith."

She was a member of Jackson County Medical Auxiliary, Indiana State Medical Association Auxiliary, American Legion Auxiliary, and served as state president of Women's Auxiliary to Indiana State Medical Association in 1964-65.

Born Oct. 5, 1913, in St. Mary's, Ohio, she was the daughter of the Rev. Earl E. and Lola F. Alderman Pedicord. She married Dr. Jack E. Shields on June 10, 1932,

in Indianapolis. He survives.

Other survivors include two sons, Jack R. Shields, Batesville; and Joseph E. Shields, Greensburg; a daughter, Jerry K. Fitzpatrick, Phoenix, Ariz.; a sister, Gladys Ratliff, Brownstown; six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
