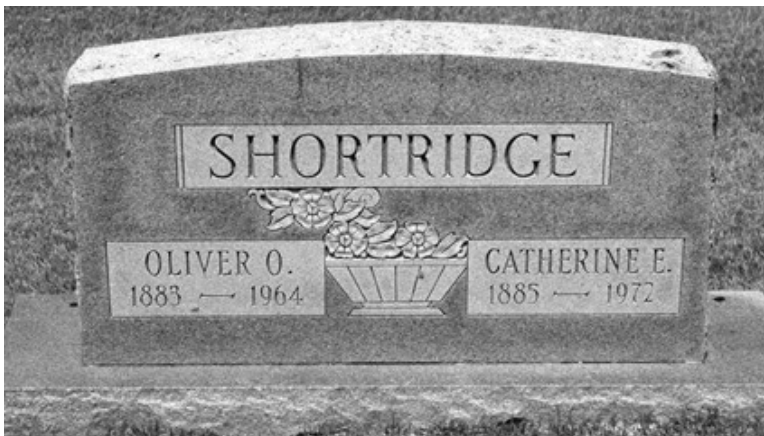

Mrs. Catherine "Kate" Shortridge, 87, Brownstown, died early Sunday, Nov. 12, at Jackson County Hospital after being in failing health for 9 weeks.

Born at Medora, she was the daughter of the late Robert C. and Mary Owen Holmes. In 1905 she married Oliver O. Shortridge, who died in 1964.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church, Brownstown, a member of the Brownstown Study Club and Brownstown Chapter 264. Order of Eastern Star. She was a past worthy matron of the chapter and also had organized an OES chapter in Medora. Active in Red Cross work, she also took part in Extension homemakers work and was a county Extension Homemakers Council past president. The county's homemakers honored her with a "Kate Shortridge Day" in recognition of her contribution to Extension homemakers.
