Retired Vallonia Farmer Succumbs

Charles P. Silence, 70, of Vallonia, retired Jackson County farmer, died at 6:30 p. m. Thursday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Marie Douglas, there. He had been in ill health for over two years, but only seriously ill for one week.

Mr. Silence moved to this county from Scottsburg about 50 years ago. He was a member of the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene and a veteran of World War I.

He was born on March 9, 1894, in Scottsburg RR, the son of the late William and Sarah Margaret Nowling Silence. He was married on September 20, 1919, in Scottsburg, to Faye England, who preceded him in death on December 20, 1960.
