Funeral services for Mrs. Julia Ann Silence, 88, of Brownstown, who died early Sunday morning at the home, will be conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Church of the Nazarene in Brownstown, with the Rev. E. M. Sutherland, of this city, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown. *March 13 1949*

Mrs. Silence, who was a member of the Brownstown Nazarene Church, had been in failing health for three years, and had been bedfast for several months, with her illness having been considered critical for some time.

Born June 11, 1860, in Tennessee, Mrs. Silence was first married to John Wesley Blevins, who preceded her in death. She was then married to William H. Silence, who survives.

Mrs. Silence leaves many friends who join with relatives in mourning her death.

Survivors include the husband; three sons, Jesse L. Blevins and George Henry Blevins, both of this city, and Harry Blevins, of Cincinnati; two stepsons, Charles Silence and Earnest Silence, both of Brownstown; 11 grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren, and four great-great-grandchildren.
