Skinner—George E. Skinner, whose sickness has been mentioned, passed away at his home in Brownstown Thursday morning, September 5, at 2:20 o'clock, following a twelve days' illness of typhoid fever, aged 36 years and 12 days.

George Edward Skinner, eldest son of Warren and Ida Crane Skinner, was born at Heighten Hill, Carr township, August 23, 1893. On June 13, 1914, he was united in marriage to Miss Eltha Sterling. To their union was born one daughter, Ruby, who with his wife, survives him. He also leaves his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Warren Skinner, and one brother, Earl Skinner, of Brownstown township, besides a host of other relatives and friends.

He united with the Brownstown Baptist church February 21, 1909, under the ministry of Rev. Owen and remained a faithful member until death. He was devoted to his family and enjoyed spending his leisure time with them. His one aim in life was to make them happy. For some time past he was employed as a machinist at the Morgan canning factory.

Funeral services, which were largely attended, were held at the Baptist church Sunday afternoon in charge of the Rev. S. D. Aubuchon. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
