Heart Attack Fatal To Brownstown Man

Edward Smith, 68, of Brownstown, died at 11 o'clock Monday night at Schneck Memorial Hospital, Seymour, where he was taken following a heart attack at his home Sunday.

Funeral services will be conducted from the home at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon and at 2 o'clock from the Brownstown Nazarene Church with the Rev. Eldor Cornett officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Born in Washington, Ind., March 17, 1888, Mr. Smith was the son of George and Caroline Mahoney Smith. He was married January 15, 1922, in Decatur, Ill., to Olive Short, who survives.

Mr. Smith was a pressman for the Brownstown Banner. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of the American Legion. He attended the Nazarene Church.

Besides the widow, Mr. Smith is survived by one son, James Edwin, at home, and one sister, Mrs. S. O. Benjamin of Washington, Ind.
