Funeral for General Mack Smith, 58, of Clifford was at 1 p.m. Monday, Nov. 8, at the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home at Brownstown.

The Rev. Robert E. Emily officiated and burial was at Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.

Smith died of an apparent heart attack at 4:45 p.m. Friday, Nov. 5, at the Bartholomew County Hospital at Columbus. He had been ill four years but death was unexpected.

The World War II Navy veteran had retired from the former Hamilton Gas-co Inc. plant at Columbus after more than 20 years employment. He attended the Hilltop Pentecostal Church near Freetown.

Born Feb. 12, 1924, in Crab Orchard, Ky., he was a son of the late Lloyd W. and Susie Proffitt Smith. He married the former Mildred L. Kinworthy in Brownstown on Feb. 21, 1946, and she survives.
