Lloyd W. Smith Dies Suddenly In His Home

Lloyd W. Smith, 64, 522 South Broadway, died suddenly Monday at 1 p. m. in his residence.

Mr. Smith was born in Clay County, Ky., Feb. 25, 1893, the son of the late Felix and Catherine Holland Smith. He was married on May 20, 1910 to the former Susie Proffit, who preceded him in death in February, 1956.

Employed during most of his life as a laborer, Mr. Smith was a member of the Baptist Church. He resided in Jackson County for the past 21 years, and his death is mourned by a host of friends in this and surrounding communities.
