Marinda Snyder dies in Ohio

Marinda A. Snyder, 86, formerly of Brownstown, died Thursday at Bethany Lutheran Village, Centerville, Ohio. She had been in failing health for several years.

She was a member of Southminster Presbyterian Church of Centerville. She had been superintendent of the children's Sunday school at Brownstown Presbyterian Church.

She was a former Girl Scout leader and member of Psi Iota Xi sorority, the American Legion Auxiliary, the Order of Eastern Star and Home Demonstration Unit 1.

She was born June 15, 1905, in Brownstown to Henry S. and Sarah Hogg Davis. She was married Oct. 15, 1924, in Brownstown to Howard C. Snyder, who
