Louis Sommers Dies, Rites Set Tuesday

Louis F. Sommers, 62, Brownstown R2, was dead on arrival at Schneck Memorial Hospital Saturday afternoon. He had been ill for six weeks.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Tuesday from the Brownstown Christian Church with Evan Bolejack, minister, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Sommers served on the board of directors of Marion-Kay Company and was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church which he served as an elder.
