## Mrs. Addie Spaulding Dies In Nursing Home— Rites Held Today

Funeral rites were held this afternoon from the Spurgeon Funeral Home for Mrs. Addie Spaulding, 79, of Ewing.

Ill since suffering a stroke of paralysis last July, Mrs. Spaulding died in the Shady Nook Rest Home, near Columbus, at 11:20 o'clock Sunday night. She had been a patient at the home since last October, transferred there from the Jackson county hospital.

Born in Jackson county, October 21, 1884, she was a daughter of the late George F. and Margaret George Huber.

Fifty-eight years ago Tuesday, January 14, 1905, she was married, in Jackson county, to Albert Spaulding, who survives.

With the exception of about 10 years, immediately following their marriage, when they lived in Boone county, Mr. and Mrs. Spaulding had always lived in Brownstown.

Surviving are a son, Harold Spaulding, Columbus R2, four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren, and one sister, Mrs. Lula McNiece, of Brownstown.

Mrs. Spaulding was a member of the Brownstown Baptist Church, whose pastor, the Rev. R. T. Wilkins, read the funeral service. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.
