Former B'town Resident Dies

Albert Spaulding, 85, a former Brownstown resident, died at 9 a. m. Tuesday at the Shady Nook Rest Home in Columbus. He had been seriously ill for one week.

A retired farmer, Mr. Spaulding was a member of the First Baptist Church of Brownstown.

Born Oct. 29, 1882, in Brown County, he was the son of Robert and Mary E. Buchanan Spaulding. On Jan. 14, 1905, in Jackson County, he married the former Addie Huber, who died in January, 1964.

Surviving are one son, Harold Spaulding, of Columbus R2, three brothers, Morton Spaulding, of Columbus, Smith Spaulding, of Marion, and Otto Spaulding, of Plant City, Fla.; four grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.
