Gilbert Speer, 55 Dies at B'town

Gilbert Wesley "Squatty" Speer died suddenly at 6 o'clock Sunday morning at his home in Brownstown. Death was due to coronary thrombosis. He was an automobile salesman for the Garrett Motor Company, of Croftsville.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Hague Funeral Home at Medora with the Rev. Byron E. Hinton, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Speer was born August 14, 1900, in Lawrence county, the son of the late Jacob Wesley and Margaret Elizabeth Allen Speer. He was married June 18, 1918, at Medora to Ethel Mae Booker, who survives.
