Lloyd C. Speer, 65, of 221 Sharan St., Brownstown, died at 6:30 p.m. Friday, March 29, at his home after an illness of three years.

He had retired from Jackson County Farm Bureau Co-op after 30 years.

Funeral services were held Monday, April 1, at Spurgeon Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Gary Morning of Brownstown Christian Church officiating. Burial was at Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Born Feb. 22, 1920, in Medora, Mr. Speer was a son of the late Gilbert W. Speer Sr. and Ethel M. Booker Speer.

On June 1, 1938, he married the former Thelma M. Dobbins at Bedford and she survives.
