

Dallas Spray, B'town Man, Dies Today

Dallas C. Spray, 91, 803 West Spring street, Brownstown, died at 12:50 a. m. this morning at the Columbus Convalescent Center. He had been seriously ill since March 9.

A retired farmer, Mr. Spray was active in the Democratic party, serving as county commissioner for nine years. He was a member of Seymour Lodge No. 482, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks; Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, Brownstown, Seymour Aerie No. 655, Fraternal Order, of Eagles; Scottish Rite and Murat Shrine.

Born Jan. 22, 1885, in the Pleasant Grove community, he was the son of the late John and Lizzie Lahrman Spray. He was a lifelong resident of Jackson Countý.

In April, 1916, in Brownstown, Mr. Spray married Zella Cross, who preceded him in death in December, 1945.

Survivors include two sons: Harry C. Spray, Seymour R6, Roscoe Spray, Brownstown R1; two daughters, Mrs. Russell (Reva) Rumph, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Glen J. (Juanita) VonDielingen, of North Vernon; six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. A son, Dallas C. Spray, Jr., preceded him in death.
