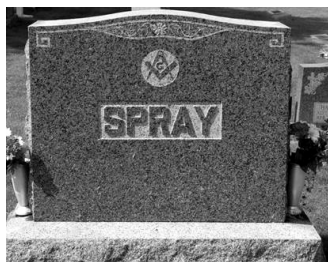

Harry C. Spray, 66, Seymour Rt. 6. died at 7:45 p.m. Sunday, April 12, at the Bedford Medical Center. He had been in failing health for eight years.

An Army veteran of World War II, he retired after working 32 years for the Dept. of Agriculture ASCS office in Brownstown. He also served as executive director of the Jackson County ASCS. Mr. Spray was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, where he served as a deacon for several years, and a member of Brownstown American Legion Post 112.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, he was born Aug. 14, 1920, in Jackson County to the late Dallas and Zella Cross Spray.

On April 18, 1942, he married Virginia Carmichael in Columbus, and she survives.

Other survivors include one son: Harry C. Spray, Jr., Trenton, Mo.; two daughters: Mrs. William (Elizabeth) Helwig, Cortland, and Mrs. Richard (Mary Lou) Thayer, Verona, Italy; one brother: Roscoe Spray, Vallonia; two sisters: Mrs. Russell Rumph and Mrs. Glen VonDielingen, both of Brownstown; and six grandchildren.
