John Henry Spray, one of the oldest and most prominent citizens of Pleasant Grove, passed away at his home Wednesday evening, Dec. 23, 1925, aged 77 years, 2 months and 15 days.

He was the son of Christian and Margaret Spray and was born October 8, 1848, near Sauers. He was one of a family of ten children, only one brother, William, of Jonesville, surviving him. He was united in marriage to Lizzie Lahrman. To this union were born three children, a son and a daughter dying in infancy, and Dallas C., with whom he was living at the time of his death.

He united with the Methodist church at Pleasant Grove in March, 1891, and was at one time official member of the church. He was a good neighbor and always ready to help those who were in need. He leaves an aged companion, one son and four grandchildren to mourn their loss.

Funeral services were held at the Brownstown Christian church Saturday morning at 10:30 o'clock, Rev. T. J. Anthony, Rev. John Cross and Rev. F. H. Reynolds conducting the services. Burial in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.
