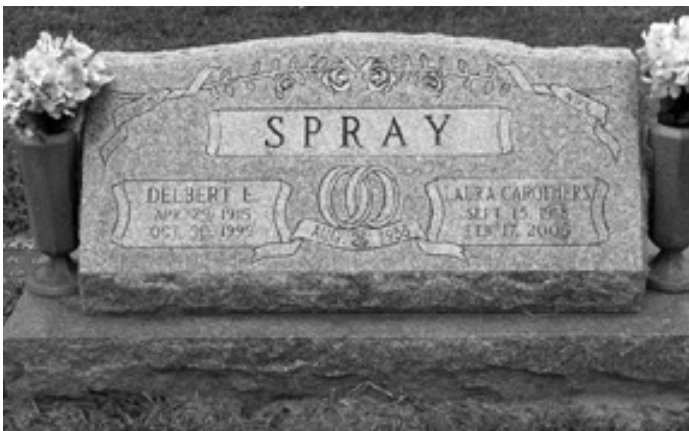

Laura Spray, 86, a resident of Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown, died at 3:45 a.m. Thursday, Feb. 17, at Schneck Medical Center, Seymour.

She was a member of Brownstown Church of the Nazarene and had retired in 1978 after 11 years as owner and manager of Laura's Cafe in Ewing. She had worked previously at Arvin Ind. for 15 years.

She was born Sept. 15, 1918, in Brown County, a daughter of Thornton and Vina Carothers. In 1936, she married Herman Lambert, and he died in 1955. On August 25, 1956, in Columbus, she married Delbert E. Spray, and he died Oct. 30, 1999.

Survivors include six stepchildren, Donald Spray and Thelma Spray, both of Brownstown, Richard Spray of Seymour, Gerald Spray of Freetown, Jerry Spray of Ballwin, Mo., and Donna Kay Hawkins of Columbus; five grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

She was also preceded in death by three sisters, three brothers and one son.
